Senior Open Lunch Policy

In an effort to encourage students to develop the desirable characteristics needed for a successful college experience and independent living, Columbus Preparatory Academy has instituted an Open Lunch opportunity for senior students. It is the intent of the program to foster such personal attributes as maturity, reliability, good attendance, promptness, self-discipline, and collaboration. Open Lunch opportunities will be unsupervised opportunities to take lunch away from the CPA campus. Students are expected to abide by all School rules and policies during Open Lunch and are expected to maintain a high standard of community ambassadorship during these outings. **Students who fail to report to class on time, cause public disruption, or in any way fail to follow School rules and policies will be barred from participating in the program. This is a senior privilege. Students may not bring food back for anyone who does not have senior standing.** Parents are required to sign the participation portion of this form in order for their student to be allowed to participate. Parents are also required to approve transportation arrangements by initializing the appropriate spaces below. Seniors who do not have signed permission forms will not be allowed to participate in the Open Lunch opportunity. **Students must personally sign out when leaving for lunch, and sign themselves back in when returning.**
